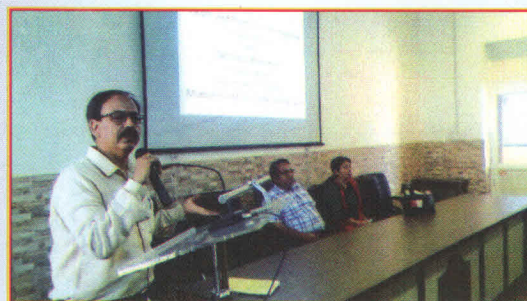
## DEPTT. OF BOTANY

## BOOK RELEASE BY MINISTER OF CULTURE & TOURISM

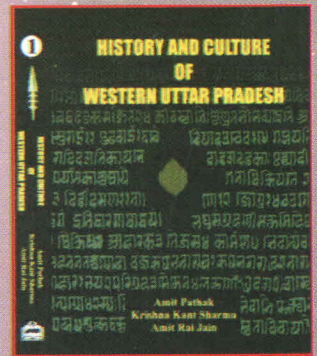


The region of western Uttar Pradesh has been historically significant since pre-historic times. The history of this region needed a comprehensive study at various levels.

The initiative was finally taken by Dr. K.K. Sharma, eminent historian and Associate Professor, Department of History, M.M. College, Modinagar. His latest offering, "History and Culture of Western Uttar Pradesh" is a pioneering work in this direction. Dr. Sharma along with co-authors, Dr. Amit Pathak and Mr. Amit Rai Jain conducted an extensive research and study of the historically relevant material which included archaeological material, literary

material, oral traditions & cultural sources for compiling this authoritative work. The book was formally released by Dr. Mahesh Sharma Culture & Tourism minister, Govt. of India. Some other prominent personalities present on the occasion were Dr. Ramesh Chandra, Ex. Vice Chancellor, Bundelkhand University, Jhansi, Dr. D.P. Singh, Mr. Prashant Jain and some others.

The book is a comprehensive work on the history and culture of Western Uttar Pradesh. It covers all the historical eras from ancient to modern. Since the region has played a pivotal role in the cultural evolution of the sub-continent, the work needed on in depth study of various historical evidences. On the basis of these evidences the book sheds invaluable light on the archaeology, history, culture, traditions and monuments of the region. ### Tulsi

The health benefits of holy basil, also known as tulsi, include oral care, relief from respiratory disorders, as well as treatment of fever, asthma, lung disorders, heart diseases and stress. Holy Basil, which has the scientific name *Ocimum* is undoubtedly one of the best medicinal herb that has been discovered.

“The essential oils found in tulsi, effectively act on our respiratory system”. Tulsi leaves have volatile and fixed oils which can help fight allergies, infections and pathogens. Tulsi paste as well as the powder has long been used in herbal and cosmetic products for its purifying, detoxifying and cleansing properties. Commonly paired with other herbs and ingredients like neem, giloy and turmeric, tulsi paste when applied on acne and pimples can ensure relief with lesser chances of repeated breakouts.
