BLACK PEPPER- THE KING OF SPICES

Black pepper, scientifically known as *Piper nigrum* L which belongs to Family Piperaceae is a rare medicinal as well spice. It is grown in south India specially in Kerala. It is a perennial vine and climber. The pepper is three typed in the market i.e. black, green and white. White pepper is called 'Dakhni-mirch'. The plant contains many antibacterial, antiviral and antifungal active constituents. It also help in the blood purification and production. It is an effective spice to cure the gut-motility, digestion power due to the secretion of gastro-intestinal enzymes. It is used in antiseptic, gum swellings, flatulence and viral fever. It also helps to control the heart rate and blood pressure. Black pepper is the good source of minerals like potassium, calcium, calcium, zinc, iron, copper, manganese, magnesium etc. It contains vitamin-B complex (pyridoxine, riboflavin, thiamine, and niacin.), Vitamin-C, Vitamin-A, flavonoids, carotenoids, cryptoxanthin, zeaxanthin and lycopene. The compounds remove the harmful free radicals from the body and protect from cancer.



Dakhni mirch are used in the enhancement of the eye vision. The powder of kernel of Meenaks is mixed with black pepper in equal parts and given three times in a day. Dosage -3-4 grains for adults and 1-2 grains for children. It is also useful in liver disease, aphrodisiac, fever mouth problems and in urinary problems.

Note: Excessive amount of black pepper can cause gastrointestinal irritation, bleeding from ulcer sites, acid-peptic disease, stomach ulcers, ulcerative colitis can be seen.
