

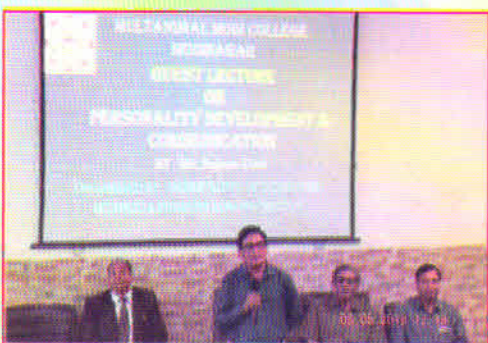

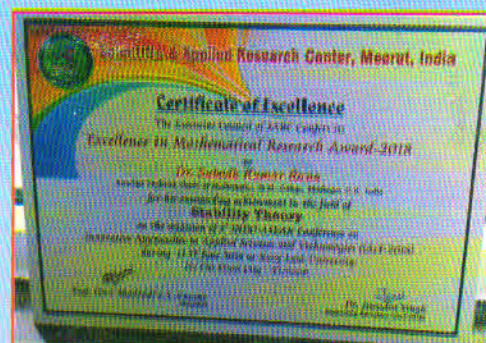


GUEST LECTURE IN DEPTT. OF COMPUTER SCIENCE AND BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

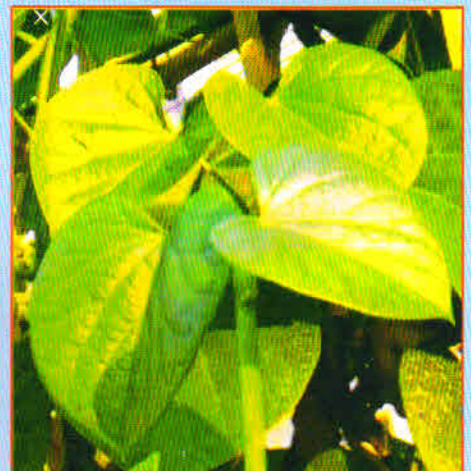
HEALTH CORNER

GILOY

Heart – leaved Moon Seed or Giloy is botanically known as *Tinospora Cardfolia*. It belongs to family menispermacea. It is a large, deciduos extensively spreading, climbing shrub with several elongated twining branches. Flowers are unisexual, small on separate plants and appear when plants is leafless, greenish yellow on axillary and terminal raceme.

Giloy in known to strengthen immunity and vitality. In Ayurvedic medicine, it is known as 'Guduchi' and considered to be one of the most divine herbs. In sanskrit, it is referred to as 'Amrita' means elixir of immortality, due to its great life-saving and immunity enhancing properties. It helps flush out toxins and rejuvenates the body's properties. It is high in antioxidant and has anti-ageing properties. It is considered to be anti-diabetic, anti-pyritic, anti-spasmodic, anti-inflammatory, anti-arthritis, anti-allergic, anti-stress, liver protecting and immunity modulatory. It acts as a diuretic and helps in dissolving urinary crystals and combats urinary tract infections.
