#### **HOLY BASIL-TULSI**

Ocimum tenuiflorum (synonym Ocimum sanctum), commonly known as holy basil, tulsi in Hindi. It is an aromatic perennial plant and native to the Indian subcontinent and widespread as a wild and cultivated plant throughout the Southeast Asian region. Tulsi is cultivated for religious, medicinal, and for essential oil.

It's known species are the cooking herb Cooking basil, O. basilicum and medicinal herb Tulsi (holybasil), O. tenuiflorum. The active chemical constituents of tulsi are oleanolic acid, ursolic acid, rosmarinic acid, and essential oils like eugenol, carvacrol, linalool,  $\beta$  caryophyllene,  $\beta$  elemene and and germacrene. O. sanctum extracts have some antibacterial activity against E coli. S aureus and P. aeruginosa. Tulsi leaves are considered as an essential part in the worship of Hindu Gods. Vaishnavas traditionally use Hindu prayer beads made from tulsi stem and roots.



Tulsi has been used for thousands of years for its diverse healing properties. It is mentioned in the Charaka Samhita. Tulsi is helpful for adapting to stress and considered as a kind of "elixir of life" and believed to promote longevity. Tulsi extracts are used as herbal tea, dried powder, fresh leaf or mixed with ghee. Essential oil extracted from Kapoor tulsi is mostly used for medicinal purposes and in herbal cosmetics. The dried leaves are mixed with stored grains to repel insects or mosquitoes.

#### Some important species of Tulsi:

- 1. Gambhira (Ocimum americanum): leaves used for skin disease.
- 2. Sweet Basil (Ocimum basilicum): used in condiment mixture, cosmetics, perfumes and seeds used as beverage.
- 3. Ram tulsi/ Vriddha tulsi (Ocimum gratissimum): used as medicine in the rheumatism and paralysis.
- 4. Kapoor tulsi/Kala tulsi (Ocimum kilimandskaricum): used as source of camphor and essential oil.
- 5. Holy basil (Ocimum sanctum): used as condiment.
- 6. Fever plant of Sierra leone (Ocimum viride): Leaves used in cough and fever.
