Dr K.K. Sharma, Associate Professor, Dept. of History, was awarded with








HEALTH CORNER

Nirgundi (Vitex negundo) is a deciduous shrub found in many parts of the globe. The word nirgundi derived from Sanskrit means keeping the body free from all diseases. It is belived that the plant originated in India and the Philippines. There is no reference to nirgundi in the Vedas but found in post-Vedic documents. The plant is used in basketry, dyeing, fuel, food, stored-grain protectant, field pesticide, growth promoter, manure, as medicine for poultry, livestock, and humans. It is also used in all systems of treatment – Ayurveda, Unani, Siddha, Homeopathy, and Allopathy and seen in folk medicine of India, Bangladesh, China, Philippines, Sri Lanka, and Japan. It is used to treat ailments like headache, migraine, skin infection, wounds, swelling, asthmatic pains, male and female sexual and reproductive problems. It is taken in a



variety of ways, both internally and externally. The whole plant, leaves, leaf oil, roots, fruits, and seeds are administered in the treatment of specific diseases.
