Multanimal Modi College is a co-educational Govt. Aided College located in Modinagar. It was established in 1957 by the highly reputed Modi family for upliftment of the society, and fulfills the need of Higher Education for the public of Modinagar and adjoining areas. Hon'ble Late Seth Kedarnath Modi gave his special attention and took great interest in the development of the college. In his times, the college achieved new heights. Eighteen Programmes /Departments are running in the college and nearly 2800 students are studying in the college in several courses.

In the academic session 2018-19, there were 2479 students in regular courses and 410 students in self-finance courses.

At present in the academic session **2019-20**, 2630 students have taken admission in regular courses and **442** students have been admitted in self-finance courses till date.

Recent Achievement of the college:

It is a matter of feeling proud that Dr. K.K.Sharma, Associate Professor, Department of History of the college has been awarded “Saraswati Samman” by Governor and Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh on Teachers’ Day i.e. September 5th, 2019 at Governor House Lucknow. Dr. K.K.Sharma selected only amongst the teachers of Govt. and Govt. aided college. In this award Dr. Sharma received cash amount of 3 Lacs and appreciation letter and memento. Dr. K.K.Sharma has done pioneer work in the ancient historical research on Yamuna-Hindon Doab. He has published 6 books and more than 35 research journals in peer review journals. He has supervised around 18 research scholars for Ph. D. The college family congratulates Dr. K.K.Sharma for his great achievement.





It is also a matter of great pleasure that the college has been awarded DST-FIST programme by the Department of Science and Technology, New Delhi in 2016. Under this scheme a Central Instrumentation Lab is developing.

It is also a matter of great pleasure that the college has been awarded UGC-CPE programme December 2016 for next 5 years. The necessary developments are under process.

Biometric attendance system is running successfully for teaching and non-teaching staff of the college for both govt. aided as well professional courses.

The progress of the college has been exemplary and the institution has achieved new heights in following aspects:

College Infrastructure:

Library: Central library of the college is well equipped and fully computerized. Approx. 1.35 lakhs books are available in the Central library. It is enriched not only with text books, but research books as well. Works of Indian and foreign authors are also available in the library. There are separate sections for Sciences, Arts and Commerce in the library. Three books are issued to each student at one time and thus she/he can consult many books one by one. College library has a well-equipped and spacious reading room, in which many newspapers, magazines etc are available for students as well as

teachers. 17 Indian and foreign journals are subscribed in the library that are easily accessible to students, E-library was also set up with 21 computers. College has subscribed to N-LIST and DELNET, online resources through which faculty members, students of post-graduate classes, and research scholars can access wide range of journals, books, magazines, etc.

From the session 2016-17, a separate Central library named as “**Dr. Rangnathan Library for Professional Studies**” has been running successfully for all self-financed professional courses, such as BBA, BCA, BPES, B.Lib., M.Lib., M.Sc. (Biotechnology) and NIELIT courses ‘O’ level, ‘CCC’ & ‘BCC’. This library has a collection of more than 8000 books and it subscribes 8 research journals.

Lecture Rooms: From UGC-CPE grant eight classrooms have been converted into well-furnished and fully equipped smart classes. In the new present scenario, smart classes are the basic need of teaching. Besides smart classes, 54 lecture rooms are also available in college for teaching.

Laboratories: The College now has well-equipped laboratories in Department of Chemistry, Botany, Zoology and Physics Departments. Many advanced equipment are installed in laboratories for Research, and for conducting practical classes for the students. In Chemistry Department, recently purchased Fully Computerized Auto Titrator for M.Sc. students is working smoothly and purchasing of other latest instruments is being processed from UGC-CPE grant.

Computer Laboratories: College has approx. 250 computers now and 50 new Computers have been purchased under the UGC general development and add on grants. Seven computer labs are running in various departments of the college. An Annual maintenance contract (AMC) has been extended for further one year to maintain all the hardware of the college.

Microsoft Edu cloud: By the grace of President Sir, the college has got licensed software for all the computers available in the college under the Microsoft Edu cloud which consists of latest licensed version of MS-Window, MS-Office and Anti-virus.

Local Area Network (LAN) : A LAN system has been established in entire college campus for using Intra-net facilities in which any staff or teacher will be able to access their data/work at any computer in the college campus. This system is controlled by a high capacity IBM Server which is installed in IQAC office of the college.

Renovation Work:

By the grace of President Sir, 08 smart class rooms have been developed in the college and teaching learning process in these classes is running very well. Physical Chemistry laboratory is fully developed for the Central Instrumentation Laboratory under the DST-FIST scheme.

Major and Minor Research Projects:

Two minor research projects are completed under Dr.(Smt.) Basudha Sharma, Head of Botany Department and Dr. A.S. Kashyap, Deptt. Of Botany. One Major research project is also completed under Dr. Ravi Kumar, Chemistry department by DST. One major research project is ongoing under the Dr. Vijay Garg, Head of the Physics Department by Uttar Pradesh Science and Technology department. Dr. Ravi Kumar is writing one major research project to NRCB ,DST and one major project to be submitted by Dr.K.K.Sharma to ICSSR.
